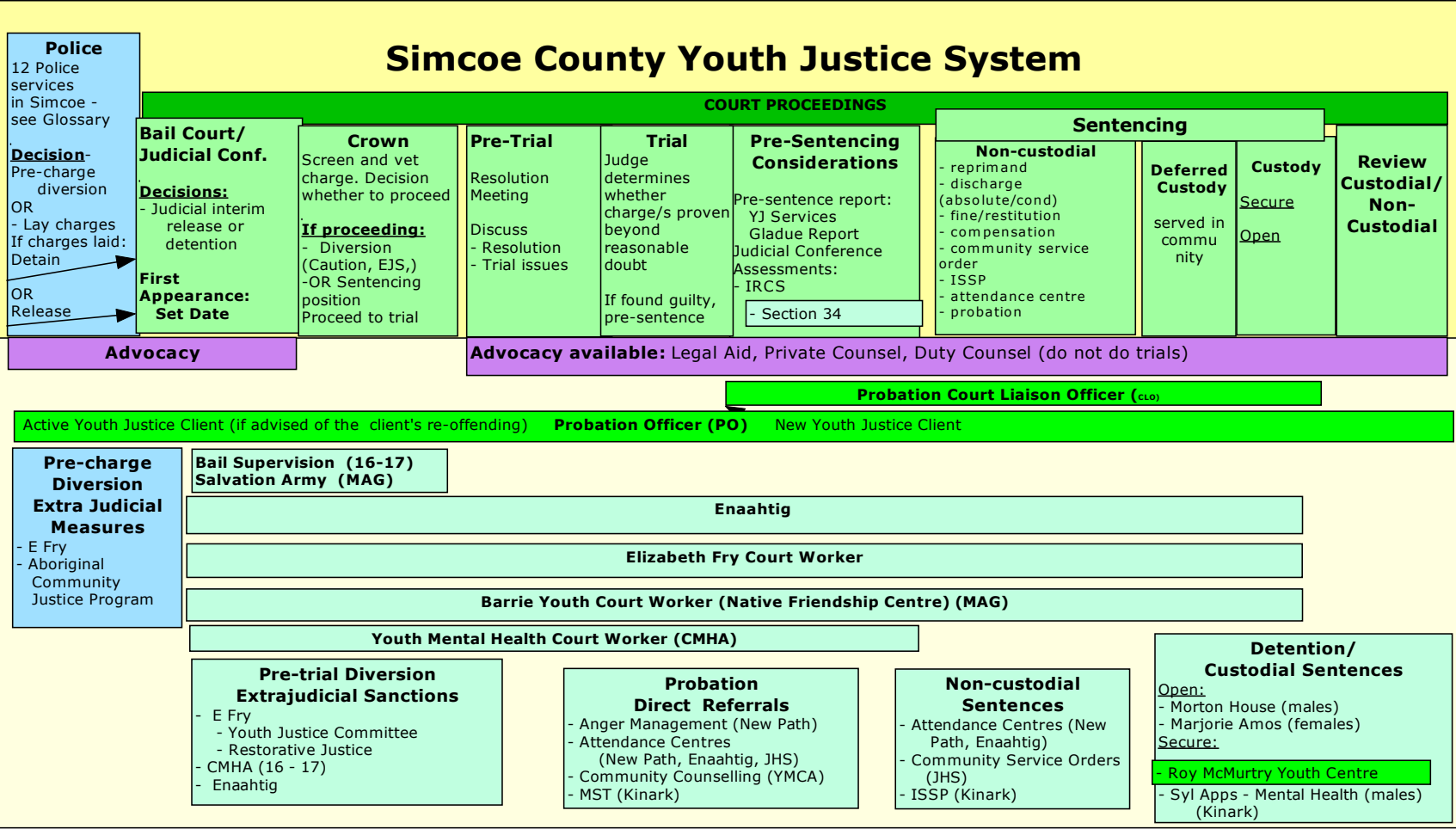

# Simcoe County Youth Justice System

The Youth Criminal Justice Act (YCJA) sets out the principles and procedures for the courts and police in dealing with offenses committed by young people, aged 12 to 17.

- The YCJA gives provinces some flexibility to design their systems to reflect their philosophies and respond to the specific needs of their jurisdictions.
- In Ontario, the provincial government encourages communities to implement the YCJA through a blend of services directly operated by the province and services delivered by community-based agencies.

The Simcoe Youth Justice System Map illustrates how these services are delivered locally. The chart consists of four parts, with the youth justice process and formal YCJ services in the middle, surrounded by the range of community-based services that all young people and their families may use, regardless of involvement in the Youth Criminal Justice system.

The stages of the Youth Criminal Justice system are shown against a yellow background, beginning with the Police role (shown in blue), which leads to the youth criminal justice processes (shown in light green).

There are 12 police services in Simcoe County:

Anishinabek Police Service, Barrie Police, Barrie OPP, Borden Military Police, Collingwood OPP, Huronia West OPP, Majikaning Police, Midland Police, Nottawasaga OPP, Orillia OPP, South Simcoe Police, Southern Georgian Bay OPP

The services associated with the Youth Justice system are shown against a light yellow background. The boxes are positioned to indicate where, in the various stages of the youth justice process, they are involved. There are two categories of services:

- Services directly operated by the Ministry of Children and Youth Services (green)
- Services delivered by community-based agencies, or transfer payment agencies, which are funded by the province (shown in blue/green). These services are available only for young people involved in the youth justice system.

The formal youth justice system operates in the context of the broader community. The wide range of services and programs (shown in pink) are available to any resident and are very important in preventing young people from getting involved with the youth justice system or in ensuring success in diversion, case management and re-integration into the community.

These community-based services range from the education system and health system, which are fundamental to the well-being of the whole community, to more specialized services, such as substance abuse programs and crisis/help lines that are used by smaller portions of the community.

Most organizations serve all of Simcoe County. Where service is available only to a specific community, it is shown with the name of the community or with initials.
