

## **New Path Youth and Family Services**

### **Project Manager**

#### **3 month Secondment Opportunity**

**As part of New Path's Lead Agency role, we are committed to making the referral and access process for children and youth, and their parents, seeking mental health services less complicated and much easier to ensure the right service, at the right time, and in the right place. To this end, a number of walk-in clinics have now been developed across Simcoe. For our next stage, we are now seeking a contract Project Manager to assist in the development of an integrated access system for those clients referred for services in the more complex Counselling and Therapy core programs of New Path, La Cle, and Kinark. The Project Manager position would be an ideal short term secondment opportunity for an agency in Simcoe County.**

**Project deliverables include the development of a work plan including gaining understanding of the current interRai Child and Youth mental health tool, understanding the current wait lists of the three core service providers, and understanding how determinations are made for Counselling and Therapy programs. Next is to develop and implement a plan, built upon consensus, as to how to triage and prioritize those particular service requests.**

**Experience in project management is required along with consensus building expertise. In addition, some familiarity with mental health services, particularly within the child and youth sector(s) would be helpful, along with the initiative and ability to self manage and secure the deliverables. This is a short term secondment (2-3 months) with an anticipated end date of approximately April 30, 2019.**
